UNIT ELECTIONS

The election process in Units is governed by the USW international Union Constitution and by other By-laws of TC Local 1976.

The term of office for these elections has been extended until April 2012. The current mandates within all units will be completed by April 2012, date on which all units and/or units/lodges will have to comply with the provisions of the International Constitution, which stipulates that the elections will serve a term of three (3) years.

ELIGIBILITY

**No member can be both, a candidate or hold more than one of the following positions:
President of the unit and Recording Secretary.**

No member may be presented as a candidate for a position within the unit or unit/lodge, unless you are a member employed by a company for which the Unit claims jurisdiction. This provision shall remain in force for the duration of the mandate.
